## 2022 MILESTONE - OFFICIAL LAUNCH OF NEW CHILD HOPE CENTER - BATIMA



In partnership with Africa Hope Initiatives, Mission Life opened its first Child Hope Center in the rural village of Batima. Batima is located south of Kigali in the Bugasera District. This area is known for seeing very little rainfall which puts a strain on being able to grow crops. Pastor Nicodem and his wife, Therese lead the community here. They have six children of their own and in 2019, they made personal sacrifices to complete renovations to keep their church open. This village really needs our help. Among other things, many of these families can't afford to send their children to school. Africa Hope Initiatives says it will be a great privilege for their community to have the Child Hope Center to support them with a Christian foundation and give them the opportunity to learn.

Africa Hope Initiatives has developed a comprehensive plan to establish an after-school program called the Child Hope Center in Batima. In partnership with Mission Life, the Child Hope Center will provide the following:

- a daily meal
- Bible lessons
- homework help
- sports
- crafts
- school fees and supplies

All of this, and more, will be provided in a comfortable and safe environment where strong relationships can be formed between children, parents, and educators.

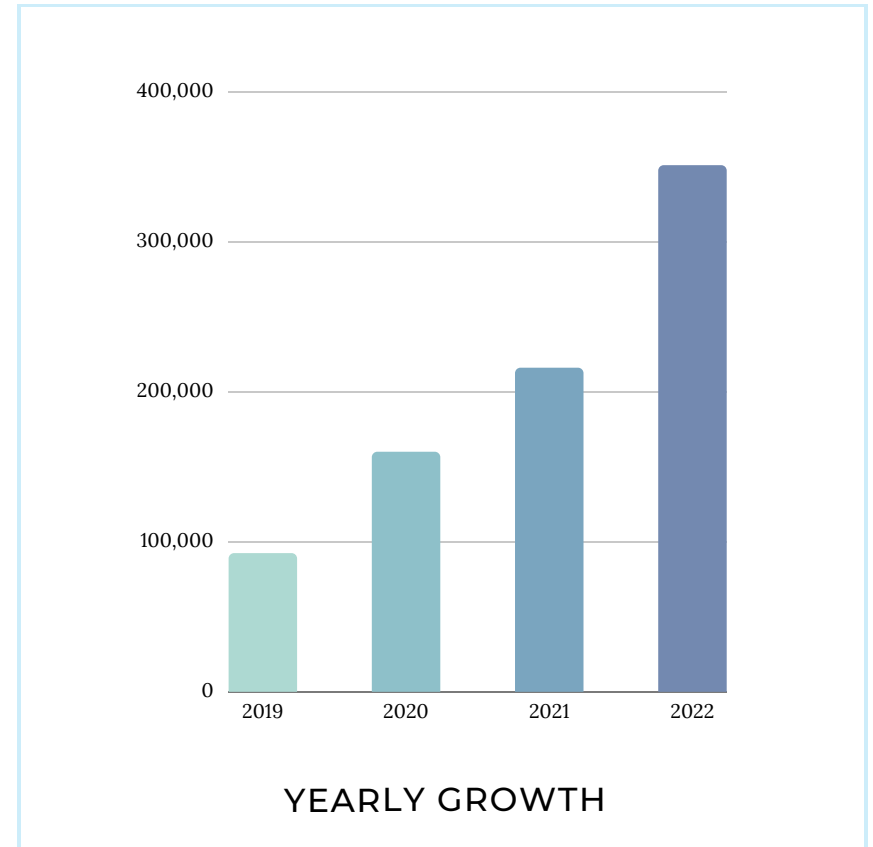

### Composition of Total Net Assets

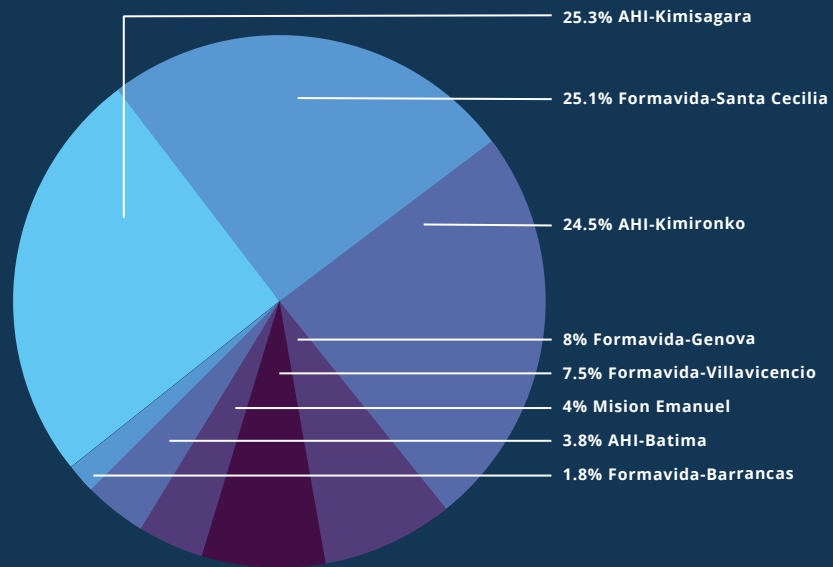

# IMPACT-AFRICA



The Child Hope Centers of Africa Hope Initiatives and Mission Life significantly impacted the lives of vulnerable children and families in Rwanda in 2022. At Kimironko Child Hope Center in Kigali, Rwanda, we piloted a preschool program to provide early education to children aged three and up. The program is designed to be slightly different from the after-school programs offered at other centers, focusing on early childhood education and development. The teachers at the center created a curriculum that included language and literacy development, numeracy, social and emotional learning, and physical development. They also provided the children with healthy meals and snacks and engaged them in play-based learning activities to support their overall development.

The impact of the preschool program is significant. The children who participate are better prepared for formal schooling and show higher levels of social and emotional development and improved cognitive skills compared to children who only attend the after-school programs at a later age. Centers like the one in Kimironko have significantly impacted the lives of these children, their families, and their communities, providing hope and a brighter future.

## UNH MARKETING EXPERIENCE



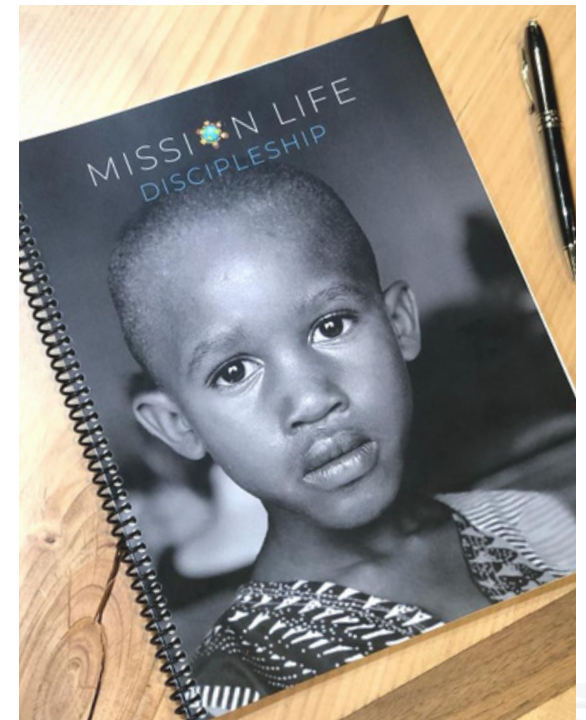

## WHILE SEEKING PURPOSE

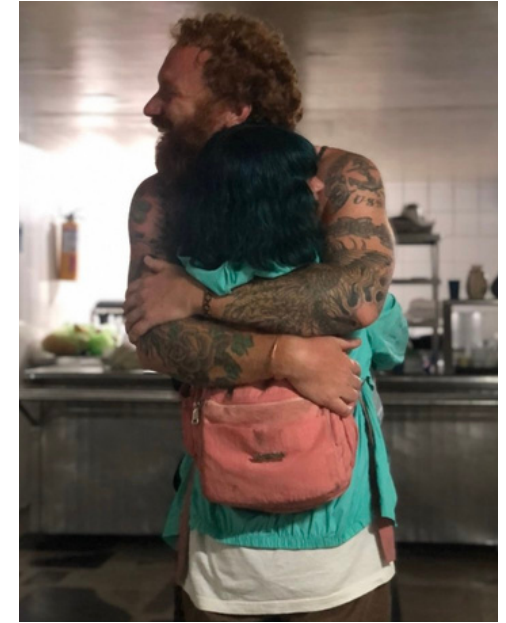
*Jason Snook has been Sophia's sponsor for 3 years. He tells us what it was like to meet her and visit the center for the first time.*
